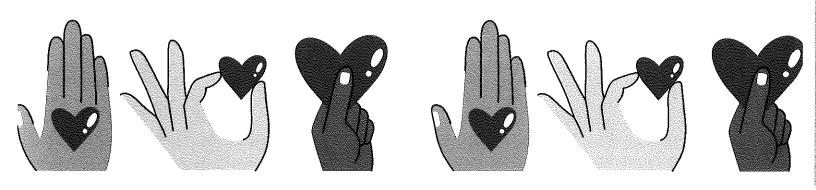


Join us to celebrate Great Kindness week by dressing in the following ways throughout the week of 1/22!

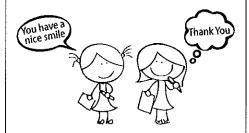
