

**FLEMINGTON-RARITAN REGIONAL BOARD OF EDUCATION

August 20, 2012

The Board returned to public session at 6:32 p.m. in the Auditorium.

CITIZENS ADDRESSED THE BOARD

Mr. Larmore made a statement that the Board is aware of the community concerns this evening regarding Rosh Hashanah. He stated that the Board will review this matter at a committee level for this year and for future years.

Tamala Buza, Flemington Borough, wants the buses to come down the road. She asked the Board to help. She gave the information to Janine Foreman.

Rabbi Jaffe of the Jewish Community has positive things to say about the Flemington community and our schools. He noted about twice every 10 years we have both Jewish Holidays fall on school days. He cited several schools in New Jersey who are closed both days. He shared how important childhood memories are for children during the holidays. He asked the Board to honor the request of the Jewish community and close school on Rosh Hashanah.

Karen Walsh, parent and educator of Jewish Hebrew School, shared how important the services are on a high holiday. She noted that we, the school, often celebrate diversity. She asked the Board to consider changing the calendar.

Kelli Ellenburgh, Parent, asked if the children will be responsible for the content missed on the Jewish Holidays. She felt it was unfair to have children be responsible for it. It forces the children to make a choice between school and their religion. She expressed disappointment.

Eric Wasserman, Raritan Township, asked if Hunterdon Central was shared our calendar. Mr. Nolan stated yes. Mr. Wasserman stated he knew for a fact Hunterdon Central made an oversight. He asked if it is a problem to change the calendar. He knows that the calendar always changes. He stated that we should not follow Hunterdon Centrals lead; they are so insensitive that they scheduled a Board Meeting on Rosh Hashanah. He wants us to follow Readington's lead and not Hunterdon Centrals.

Lori Ann Moore, Teacher and Teacher at the Synagogue, stated telling kids they have to come to school on Rosh Hashanah is like telling Christians they need to come to school on Christmas.

Debra Fauser, resident, does not understand why the district chose Yom Kippur to have off versus Rosh Hashanah. She contacted an assembly woman who wrote a letter to Flemington Raritan School District.

Sharon Cawas, parent, is very upset that her daughter has to miss school because of her religion.

Sandra Gorg, parent, is not Jewish but her family is. She understands that these two holidays are very important. She asked the Board to reconsider changing the calendar.

Marie Corfield, resident and teacher, noted that teachers are very excited about the new classrooms at Robert Hunter. The teachers are also very concerned about getting into the classrooms on August 30th. She expressed concerns with the late timeline. She is coming to Board as a teacher representative. The teachers are panicking. She asked for the teachers to be excused from the opening session on the first day (1-1/2 hours).

Kevin Walker, parent, has a son with ADD. He participates in the Copper Hill Project Happy program. His child attends a daycare outside of the sending area. He is asking the Board to transport his son to Rainbow Academy so he can continue his education.

Elana Corn, resident, is a practicing Jew. Her children will never go to school on these two Jewish holidays. She reiterated how very important these holidays are.

Lea Klein, resident and teacher, expressed great thanks to the Jewish community. She asked the Board to consider the request.

Mr. Larmore thanked everyone for their comments.

SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT

Mr. Masessa and Ms. Strunk presented the ESL program. They stated that about 80 students attend school after school lets out, 2 hours a day for 10 days. Mr. Masessa created a movie to share with the Board with all of the activities that take place in the ESL program. The program is intended to develop additional educational skills beyond the school year. Mr. Masessa recognized the 7 teachers that ran the ESL program. He also thanked Mr. Bland and our supervisors for their support.

0151 – Organization Meeting -- P.L. 2011, Chapter 202 established procedures for moving the date of school elections and requires a revision to Bylaw 0151 – Organization Meeting for those school districts moving the school election from April to November.

Bylaw 0151 has been revised to provide the option for organization meeting dates for an April or November election. In addition, organization meeting dates for county vocational school districts and county special services school districts were added in this Bylaw. Bylaw 0151 is RECOMMENDED.

0153 – Annual Appointments -- P.L. 2010, Chapter 39, makes it optional for a school district to employ a Treasurer of School Moneys. Bylaw 0153 – Annual Appointments has been revised to make the appointment of a Treasurer of School Moneys optional. Bylaw 0153 is RECOMMENDED.

0167 – Public Participation in Board Meetings -- New Jersey's Open Public Meetings Act was revised to require every Board of Education to set aside a portion of every meeting for public comment on any school district issue that a member of the public feels may be of concern to the residents of the school district (N.J.S.A. 10:4-12). The Board may determine the length of the public comment portion. Bylaw 0167 has been revised to reflect this update. In light of this requirement, a Board may want to consider one of the options limiting the amount of time for public comment or limiting the time permitted for each person who wishes to comment. Bylaw 0167 is RECOMMENDED.

2622 – Pupil Assessment -- Policy Guide 2622 has been revised to include the names of the current State assessments and has updated the term “pupil with limited English proficiency (LEP)” to “English language learner (ELL)”. Policy Guide 2622 is MANDATED.

5600 - Pupil Discipline Regulation (Addition of *Academic Integrity Regulation*) – No description available.

6470 – Payment of Claims -- Policy and Regulation Guides 6470 have been revised with an option that provides some additional flexibility in the payment of bills. N.J.S.A. 18A:19-4.1 permits the payment of claims to be made prior to Board approval at a Board Meeting provided the Board adopts a resolution designating a person, in addition to the Board Secretary, to audit and provide approval for such payments. The Board may, in its resolution, establish a maximum dollar amount for which payments may be authorized without prior Board approval. The revisions in Policy and Regulation Guides 6470 provide three levels of payment options.

One option requires the Board to authorize all claims for payments, the second option limits the payments authorized without prior Board approval to a maximum dollar amount and lists some additional claims, and the third option authorizes all payments of claims to be made prior to Board approval at a Board meeting provided the Board adopts a resolution designating a person, in addition to the Board Secretary, to audit and provide approval for such payments. The third option also provides the Board the option of establishing a maximum dollar amount for which payments may be authorized without prior Board approval. The updated Board Policy should reflect the manner in which claims are paid. Policy Guide 6470 is MANDATED. Regulation Guide 6470 is RECOMMENDED.
