GFSC Player Progression

Division 7 (Under 6), Division 6B (Under 7), Division 6A (Under 8)

Children in these groups participate in the program developed by the Canadian National coach. Parents often feel that this isn't real soccer but studies have shown that children trained through this program perform at a much higher skill level. It is designed to teach basics and emphasizes ball contact. The more a child touches the ball the faster they learn. Children in these divisions practice on Saturdays using a combination of skill stations and small sides games (3 vs. 3 up to 6 vs. 6 as they progress in divisions).

Division 5 (Under 9 and Under 10)

Play 8 vs. 8 on Sundays against other GFSC teams. Additional practice sessions are held on Saturdays or during the week.

Division 4 (Under 11 and Under 12).

Play 11 vs. 11 on Sundays against teams from other Hunterdon County programs, including, Kingwood, Delaware and South County. Additional practice sessions are held on Saturdays or during the week.

Division 3 (Under 13 and Under 14)

Play 11 vs. 11 on Sundays against teams from other Hunterdon County programs, including Kingwood, Delaware and South County. Additional practice sessions are held on Saturdays or during the week.

Division 2 (High School)

Play 11 vs. 11 on Sundays against teams from other Hunterdon County programs, including Kingwood, Delaware and South County. Additional practice sessions are held on Saturdays or during the week.
