

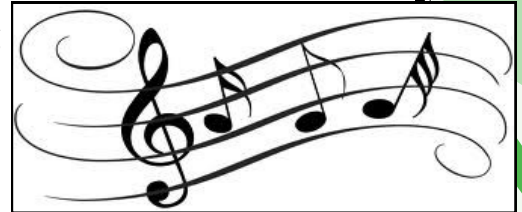


# Song Contest

## What does it mean to be GREEN?

The Flemington-Raritan Green Committee is sponsoring a song contest for all students in Grades K-8. The theme is “What It Means to Be Green.”

Students can come up with a song about what being GREEN means to them. Topics can include ideas about recycling, saving energy, reducing paper, or other ways to protect and care for our environment.



Students can make a music video, record their song as an audio file or can write their song on paper to the tune of a familiar melody. Only entries submitted by individual students will be judged. Group submissions will not be accepted. Musical instruments are encouraged!



***Please note:***

- Audio entries must be burned on a CD as an .mp4a or .mp3 file; not to exceed three minutes in duration.
- Video entries must be burned on a DVD as a .mov file; not to exceed three minutes in duration.
- Written songs must be typed or neatly printed; words must be spelled correctly; entries must include the title of the familiar tune to which the song is written.

All entries must be labeled with the student’s name, grade and school. Entries are due to the school main office by **Friday, March 23**. Entries will not be returned. Prizes will be awarded at each grade level, thanks to Maschio’s, our food service vendor. The prizes are \$50 iTunes gift cards for students in Kindergarten through Grades 8.

Winners will be announced on April 20 and will be recognized at a Board of Education meeting where they can show their video or perform their song.
