Alexea Grace Karpinski was born on October 7, 2003. "Lex" as she was affectionately known, was a junior at Hunterdon Central Regional High School when she died suddenly on November 21, 2020. She was also an honor student, a two-sport Varsity and aspiring D1 athlete, a Girl Scout and a volunteer in many community and school organizations.

Lex played multiple sports her entire life, but none brought more joy and passion than lacrosse. As a skilled goalie and dedicated all-around athlete, Lex was the starting goalie for both the Red Devil's Varsity lacrosse and field hockey teams. She also played for the Triple Threat lacrosse league and in 2019 was selected to play with the Legacy Global Sports USA team in the Czech Republic and Germany.

Once a shy and reserved young girl, Lex grew into a confident leader on and off the field. She was a constant inspiration to those around her and demonstrated through dedication and hard work that no dream was out of reach. Lex's kindness, encouragement, passion and positive attitude made her an incredible mentor, teammate and friend. She believed that every day was a chance to be greater than the day before, for herself, friends, teammates and coaches. It was important to Lex that she *prove her worth* and create a positive legacy. The Iron Girl Project, Inc. was founded by Alexea's parents, Danielle and Mike, and her brother, Brayden, to honor her memory and continue her legacy.
