RE: Annual Re-Notification required by AHERA

"The Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA) 40 CFR 763 requires all schools from pre-K to Grade 12 to conduct inspections to determine if they contain asbestos containing building materials (ACBM). If they do, the ACBM must be categorized according to the type of material, its locations, current damage, and its potential for future damage and a detailed Asbestos Management Plan must be developed. The Management Plan details the inspection findings, and outlines the response actions the School Board intends to implement.

To accomplish these goals, the School Board now has on file at each school and in the District Office a NJ State Department of Health approved Asbestos Management Plan for all school facilities. The provisions of the plan are being implemented in a timely and on-going fashion. The School Board will also schedule and perform 3-year re-inspection and 6-month surveillance as required by the AHERA regulations. It is your Board's desire to provide a safe and healthy facility for all students, employees and visitors.

The purpose of this memorandum is to satisfy the requirements of AHERA for written notice of the availability of the Management Plan for review. Should you desire, please contact the Director of Educational Facilities and Operations at (908) 284-7595 for further details.

Dear Parents and Guardians:

In accordance with the New Jersey School Integrated Pest Management Act, all families must be notified of the use of pesticides in public schools. Our district uses the following pesticides for pest control:

Maki Mini Blocks 28grms/block
Tempo 1% Dust
Resolve
Recruit HD
Advion Evolution Cockroach Gel Bait
Advion Ant Bait Gel
MaxForce FC Select Roach Bait
Round-up Pro

The United States Environmental Protection Agency and the New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection register pesticides to determine that the proper use of a pesticide does not pose a risk to human health or the environment. Nevertheless, the EPA and NJDEP cannot guarantee that registered pesticides do not pose any risk, thus unnecessary exposure to pesticides should be avoided. The EPA has issued the statement that where possible, persons who are potentially sensitive, such as pregnant women, infants and children, should avoid unnecessary pesticide exposure.

The Board of Education's Integrated Pest Management Policy is posted on the district web site at www.frsd.k12.nj.us. In addition, as the district's IPM Coordinator, I maintain the product label and material safety data sheet of each pesticide used in the district. These are available for review upon request.
