6. The school district, charter school, renaissance school, jointure commission, educational services commission, approved private school for students with disabilities acting under contract to provide educational services on behalf of New Jersey public school districts, state-funded early childcare facilities pursuant to N.J.A.C. 6A:13A, and receiving schools as defined by N.J.A.C. 6A:14-7.1(a) (hereinafter collectively referred to as "Covered Entity"), has reviewed N.J.A.C 6A:26 requiring testing for lead in drinking water and has provided assurance that the development and implementation of a testing program has been completed in accordance with the technical guidelines established by the NJ Department of Environmental Protection. Additionally, all notifications of test results have been provided consistent with this subchapter, including the requirement to make the test results publicly available on the District's website.

7. The Covered Entity will continue to fully implement the N.J.A.C. 6A:26-12.4 regulations.

The Covered Entity will maintain compliance with all applicable laws, codes, and regulations governing the provision of potable drinking water and testing of drinking water for lead including, but not limited to, N.J.A.C. 6A:26-12.4; the Safe Drinking Water Act, N.J.S.A. 58:12A-1 et seq., and the rules promulgated pursuant thereto, N.J.A.C. 7:10 and N.J.A.C. 6A:26-6, Planning and Construction Standards for School Facilities.
