~We learned about the pilgrims and the first Thanksgiving. We got to pretend to be pilgrim children by:

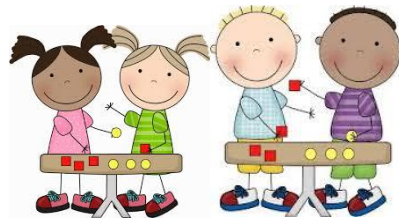
- shining pennies using vinegar and salt
