

**FLEMINGTON-RARITAN REGIONAL BOARD OF EDUCATION  
REGULAR MEETING  
SEPTEMBER 13, 2010  
MINUTES**

The regular session of the Flemington-Raritan Regional Board of Education was called to order in conformance with the "Sunshine Law" by Patrick Larmore at 6:33 p.m. in Room D111 of the J.P. Case Middle School.

**Negotiations**

The matters discussed will be made public when confidentiality is no longer required and formal action pursuant to said discussion shall take place only at a meeting to which the public has been invited.

On motion of Ms. Markowski, seconded by Ms. McGivney, the meeting was adjourned, unanimously viva voce, to executive session at 6:34 p.m.

The Board returned to public session at 7:01 p.m. in the auditorium of the J.P. Case Middle School.

A moment of silence was requested by Mr. Larmore to remember those who lost their lives on September 11 and to honor those in the Armed Forces protecting our country.

On motion of Ms. McGivney, seconded by Ms. Markowski, minutes of the Regular Meeting August 23, 2010 were approved, viva voce. Dr. Bonieski abstained.

**SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT**

Mr. Nolan recognized Ms. Hope's recent endeavor in support of pediatric cancer.

Mr. Nolan read a statement regarding facility use as attached. There were no comments from the Board.

Mr. Nolan read a statement regarding the Teacher Assistant contract as attached. There were no comments from the Board.

Mr. Nolan discussed the Strategic Plan as attached. There were no comments from the Board.

**CITIZENS ADDRESSED THE BOARD**

Mr. Larmore stated the ground rules as a one hour session with 3 minutes per citizen.

Ann Fallon, Raritan Township, asked what we are preparing in reference to school choice. Mr. Nolan will look into. She also noted she was offended by the way one of our teachers represented herself when speaking to the Governor at a recent meeting.

Dan DeCanio, President of the FREA, reminded everyone that Facility Use fees were directed at childcare and was not intended for Girl Scouts. He also expressed concern with the Teacher Assistant contract and that it was a disservice to students. He asked the Board to sit and write to Legislators. Mr. Nolan noted that he and Mr. DeCanio have agreed to open communication and will work together.

Robin Behn, Raritan Township, is concerned that FREA is not properly representing the Teacher Assistant's. The Board and FREA need to work through the Teacher Assistant issue together.

Nahed Andraos, Raritan Township, Teacher Assistant, expressed concern about training. Mr. Nolan stated contract outlines training opportunities.

Steve Barrick, Raritan Township, asked how much the district will save. Mr. Nolan stated approximately 1.3 million to 1.5 million in health benefits. Mr. Barrick asked will the Teacher Assistants be required to show proof of insurance. Mr. Nolan stated no. Mr. Nolan explained if a teacher gets hurt they are covered under workers compensation by the ESC. Mr. Barrick then asked what happened with the Readington School. Mr. Nolan explained that the Readington Teacher Assistants created a sidebar agreement with their Board.

Diana Hart, Raritan Township, asked where in Hunterdon County they could speak with other Teacher Assistants. Mr. Nolan stated only at Polytech were the Teacher Assistants outsourced with ESC.

Diana Kelly, Raritan Township, expressed concern with our teachers disrespect with the Governor. She also questioned the teachers lunch time to attend. She noted concern with the teachers telling kids how to vote. She also requested that no event occur when voting is being done. Mr. Nolan stated he trusts teachers and is a proponent of the Celebration of Learning.

Jennifer Corbin, Teacher, extended an invitation to the Board to visit classes. She asked who decides if the ESC is successful. Mr. Nolan answered that it will be a collaborative effort.

John Zak, Raritan Township, asked about estimated revenue for facility use. Mr. Nolan answered \$75,000 to \$125,000 and that it was difficult to estimate since it was based on use. Mr. Zak asked the Board to give a 90 day moratorium before taking a vote. He thinks we need to look at the impact on the children. He does not feel the township intent was for it to cost the residents.

Marie Corfield, Raritan Township, Teacher, asked if there were any long term studies done of any other districts that outsourced Teacher Assistants. Mr. Nolan referred to his past experience with similar situations.

Hugh Shannon, Bethlehem, his daughter uses our facilities and asked for clarification on theatre use. Mr. Nolan clarified. Mr. Shannon expressed concern over the impact to the program.

Lisa Clemens, Raritan Township, stated there was a crowd at the Governors meeting and we should be embarrassed. She stated she would bet that teachers are not telling kids how to vote.

Becky Testa, Raritan Township, asked about clarification on parking lot fees. Mr. Nolan clarified. She is concerned with the impact on groups. Mr. Nolan stated he will monitor it closely.

Ellen Rogers, Copper Hill Teacher, she restated Mr. Nolan's welcome address that "We all need to work together". Our Teacher Assistants are needed to be able to do their jobs.

Cindy Casazza, Teacher, will all the new Teacher Assistants that come midyear also receive training. Mr. Nolan said yes and outlined the parameters.

Jennifer Renda, Teacher, asked if the teachers that worked here will be compensated for experience and will they get sick days. Mr. Nolan said yes, there is a scale for years of service and there will be no payment for sick days.

Elli Kuras, Raritan Township, asked who has control of hiring/firing. Mr. Nolan stated ESC and the Principals will work together. It is a shared responsibility. She also questioned confidentiality of student records. Mr. Nolan stated they will see information that they need to know and the information will remain at school. She asked if parents have input to evaluate a 2 year contract. Mr. Nolan said parents have ongoing input. She also noted that she appreciates the Celebration of Learning.

Jennifer Hill, Raritan Township, concerned about facility fees. She presented another petition asking for a public vote. She also noted the money should be used to give back to the teachers. She also thinks kids' voting is a great opportunity. Mr. Nolan invited her to speak with him.

Melissa Roethke, Raritan Township, Teacher Assistant, questioned why non-profit needs to pay facility use, taxpayers are already paying and questioned where the money is going. She also asked how much money we will get from the Federal government. Mr. Nolan stated that is unknown at this time. She asked if we can get back Teacher Assistants. Mr. Nolan does not think we will get 1.5 million and that the Teacher Assistants are already employed for the 2010-2011 school year. She then asked how much money it costs to send a child out of district. Mr. Nolan stated that there are many variables. Do Teacher Assistants get unemployment? Mr. Nolan and Ms. Hope stated this has many variables as well.

Jeff Underhill, Raritan Township, asked if ESC cannot provide a Teacher Assistant for the district do we have to employ a sub and isn't that a violation of the contract. Mr. Nolan stated that substitute pooling is available and we have a large pool within the district.

Bruce Black, YMCA, estimated fees at \$80,000 – \$120,000 for their non-profit organization. He is concerned that the Strategic Plan states that childcare will be evaluated. He has never heard a complaint of the Y program and that the Board put the Y in a difficult place with fees and that they did not budget for this. Mr. Nolan responded that the Strategic Plan states to investigate and it does not state we are doing it. An investigation is an obligation of the Board. Mr. Black asked for a spirit of collaboration. He asked that the Y be included.

Mr. Larmore asked for a motion to continue with the Citizens Address the Board.

No motion was made.

The Board took a 5 minute break.
