Dr. Copeland reported that past emails have been responded to. Dr. Copeland reported that a thank you note was received from Mrs. Stagger. Dr. Copeland congratulated her for the student's accomplishment with Odyssey of Mind.

CITIZENS ADDRESS THE BOARD

Ron Tonge, resident, asked why we are going with Cat 5 cable and not Cat 6 cable for the infrastructure project. Will this support our future needs? Millennium answered Cat 6 is 20% higher in cost. They did not feel Cat 6 was necessary because of the cost but will still transmit the same amount of data to meet our needs.
