- A shoebox/pencil box filled with the following supplies:
  - Crayons
  - Glue Stick

We also encourage you to buy the following supplies to be brought into school once in-person learning resumes:

- 3 Boxes of Crayola Crayons (24 count)
- 4 Large (.77 oz) Elmer's Glue Sticks
- 4 Black Thick Low Odor Expo Dry Erase Markers
- 1 Set of Headphones (No Ear Buds)
- 1 Hard Pencil Box (Must be able to hold 1 box of crayons, 1 glue stick, pencils, a dry erase marker, and an eraser)
- 1 Box of Tissues
- 1 Box of Ziploc Freezer Bags

We ask that you please do not use the materials sent home until you are instructed to do so. Once in-person learning resumes, please ensure lunchboxes, backpacks, jackets, and all personal items are labeled with your child's name.
